The second miracle was the healing of a young Costa Rican woman who fell off her bike in Florence, Italy and suffered severe head injury. A co-worker of the girl's mother immediately began praying to Blessed Carlo and shortly afterwards the mother herself went to pray at Blessed Carlo's tomb in Assisi.
