Year of Jubilee 2025

2025 has been declared by Pope Francis as the Year of the Jubilee, the theme chosen is **"Pilgrims of Hope"**, which is particularly important today. We live in a world ravaged by wars, poverty and threatened by climate change, with many people facing increasing economic challenges. The Jubilee Year will start on Sunday, 29 December 2024, when Bishop Ralph will celebrate Holy Mass in the Cathedral as the solemn opening of the Jubilee Year.

In preparation for the Jubilee 2025, Pope Francis has said "I would greatly desire that we devote 2024, the year preceding the Jubilee event, to be a great symphony of prayer".

We have put together some ideas as to how we at St Vincent's could prepare for the Jubilee in this Year of Prayer but we would also like to invite you to contribute your suggestions. Please see the separate sheet which will be given out after mass today.
